- Não dar de comer aos baboínos
- Se um baboíno apanhar o seu saco não tente recupera-lo, ele deixará-lo cair
- Proibido dar de comer aos baboínos - multa de R500

## GERMAN

- Autotüren verschlossen halten
- Autofenster und Türen nicht öffnen
- Paviane nicht füttern
- Nimmt ein Pavian Ihre Tasche, greifen Sie nicht nach Ihr, er wird Sie fallen lassen
- Paviane zu futtern ist illegal - Geldstrafe R500

## SPANISH

- Mantenga las puertas de su automovil cerradas y active los seguros
- No abra las puertas ni las ventanillas de su automovil
- No alimente a los babuinos
- Si un babuino arrebatata su cartera/bolsa no intente recuperarla. El babuino la dejara caer
- Es ilegal alimentar los babuinos - la multa R500

## ITALIAN

- Tenete sempre le portiere dell'auto bloccate
- Non aprite i finestrini o le portiere dell'auto
- Non date da mangiare ai babbuini
- Se un babbuino afferra la vostra borsa non cercate di riprenderla - la lascerà cadere
- Dare da mangiare ai babbuini è vietato - multa R500

# Help us to keep our baboons safe and wild

Baboons that are fed by humans become aggressive and have to be shot.  
Feeding baboons is illegal.



**Do not open car windows or doors**



**Lock car doors and stay in car**



**Do not feed baboons**



**Do not grab back or hold onto bags**







**Chacma baboons form part of the Cape Peninsula's rich biodiversity and are protected under conservation law.**

**Feeding baboons is illegal and may result in the baboon becoming aggressive and having to be shot.** Fines could be as high as R10 000 or two year's imprisonment.

**Touching baboons is prohibited** and potentially dangerous as males may defend troop members from the perceived threat.

Baboons have learnt to associate cars with food. If you encounter baboons while driving: **SLOW DOWN, CLOSE your windows, LOCK your doors and stay in your car.**



**Always:**

- Store food out of sight
- Use baboon-proof bins
- Remain calm if confronted by a baboon. Sudden movements may escalate aggression
- Lock all vehicle doors and keep windows shut
- Report people feeding baboons

**Never:**

- Feed baboons
- Eat in front of baboons
- Attempt to take anything back from a baboon
- Make threatening gestures towards infants and juveniles or attempt to touch or feed them

Baboons that raid often experience conflict with people and suffer retaliatory injuries and even death. If raiding cannot be prevented by using field rangers, habitual raiders will be euthanised in the interests of baboon welfare and the conservation of the population as a whole.
